## After Dark in the Park—"Discovering Renewal at the Place of Black Tears"

Honolulu, Hawaii – "Discovering Renewal at the Place of Black Tears" presentation, a FREE After Dark in the Park Event, will be held on Saturday, May 19, 2012 at the Pearl Harbor Visitor Center, WWII Valor in the Pacific National Monument, at 6:30 pm.

**"Discovering Renewal"** will be presented by photographer and author, Jerry Kaufman, who will be sharing his photographs of the leaking oil from the USS *Arizona* wreckage. He will share new discoveries he has made through his photographs and lend a perspective of renewal and learning. Joining the discussion will be NPS Historian Daniel Martinez, who will speak about the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the USS *Arizona* Memorial and Curator Scott Pawlowski, who will discuss dive operations on the ship.
